Processing: The nomination can be submitted by the sending club or institution and has to be completed on the form that will be received with this announcement (list of nomination). Please present a confirmation of the responsible national federation.

Content of nomination:

- 1) Name, Surname, and date of birth of the competitor
- 2) Name of the club and represented Country
- 3) Category
- 4) Planned Program Content (PPC) – **please use the following link for upload.**

With the submission of the nomination the club or federation is confirming the amateur-activities in sport and the fulfilment of all participation requirements including health checks of their athletes.

Nomination fee: € 45,-- for each skater nominated in the “U” Categories
€ 50,-- for each skater nominated in Categories higher than “U”
€ 70,-- for each nominated couple/pair (Basic)
€ 80,-- for each nominated couple/pair (Advanced)
€ 220,-- for each synchronized skating team

Case of double nomination fee – please see conditions under Judges/TS/TC

The nomination fee is due with the announcement of the final list of participating competitors. The fee has to be transferred to the bank account of the Berlin Figure Skating Association.

In case the nomination fee has not been received by the BEV before the competition, the participation of the athlete or respective federation can be declined.

Please note that it is a nomination fee and we will not be able to refund the payment in case of cancelation of nomination or non-attendance.

Conditions of competition: The competitions categories will be executed according to the current ISU regulations und ISU communications as far as no other conditions are stated within the category's descriptions.

The winners (place 1-3) of all categories receive a trophy and certificate.
Victory ceremony is held for all placements and will receive a certificate.

Eligibility: For international participants (amateurs) from EU countries, who meet the conditions of participation through their club,
belong to an ISU member and being registered through their club or association.
However, please obtain the approval of the respective national association beforehand.

Limitation of participants: All participating national and international associations can register a maximum of five participants per competition.
However, the organizer reserves the right to allow a larger number of participants per category. If the number of participants is too high, the organizer has the right to reduce the number of participants. The participation of the Berlin athletes takes place according to a valid decision of the Berlin Figure Skating Association.

Judges/TS/TC: Each participating int. association is requested to send one official (TS/TC/Judge) with minimum a national qualification.
Cost for traveling, accommodation, and subsistence costs are carried by the sending association or club. The organizer does not cover any costs.
For athletes whose association or club does not send any official, the double nomination fee has to be paid with the official nomination.
The catering of the judges is organized in the ice rink.

Compensation: The costs for travel, accommodation and meals are borne by the nominating associations, clubs or participants themselves. The participants receive no compensation.

Liability: The organizer / host does not take over any liability due to accidents or other damages for the participants and officials in any event.

Calculation of results: The results for all categories are determined according to the ISU-Judging-System.

Publication & results: All competition results as well as photos & videos (including livestream) of the competition will be published online. With the nomination for the competition, the participants or their legal representatives agree to the publication.

II. Technical Data

- Schedule:** The schedule will be prepared after the deadline of nomination and will be sent out to all nominating associations or clubs.
- Draw:** The first draw will be calculated on Thursday afternoon by the official ISU Software. Starting orders of the free programs correspond to the placements of the short programs in reverse order.
- Music:** The music must be uploaded in advance via the following link
<https://dracoon.team/public/upload-shares/CuZAqQXprbTIZTvKKfks2vTptxrhGBsk>.
The Music is temporarily stored for the duration of competitions in order to be able to play it back on the competition by computer. With the transmission, you allow the processing of the music exclusively for playback purposes for the performance of the nominated athlete. The file must be named as follows:

Singles categories: Category-Surname-Name-SP/FP.mp3

(e.g.: Novice Boys-Max-Mustermann-FP.mp3)

Pairs/Dance categories: Category-Name1-Name2-SP/FP.mp3

(e.g.: Basic Novice Pairs-Müller-Schulz-FP.mp3)

For any technical problems that may occur, the participant must always bring a spare CD to the competition.

- III. Purpose of the event** For all categories, binding program content are valid. These rules must comply with the rules or recommendations of the ISU or the German Figure Skating Association.

IV. Competitions

- General:** For all categories, binding program contents as well as length and duration and other requirements apply, which must comply with the current rules or recommendations of the ISU and DEU.

1. Novice Category

The categories of advanced Novice are executed according to the current ISU regulations.

For German figure skating members the figure skating test (Kürklasse) 3 is mandatory.

Participants of the German National Novice Championships (accept Ice Dance & Pair Skating) are not allowed to participate in this competition.

Open for all participants (single, pair) fulfilling the terms of the ISU regulations for advanced novice in the present season.

1.3.1. Basic Novice Pairs (only Free Program according to newest ISU Communication)

2. Juvenile Girls and Boys (Neulinge) U 12 (calls up to level 3)

Open for participants who have not reached the age of 12 years by the 01.07.2018. Program content as stated in the Novice category according to the current ISU communications. For German figure skating members the figure skating test (Kürklasse) 6 is mandatory.

3. Age categories

3.1. Girls and Boys U 7 – 10 (calls up to level 2)

Technical & program requirements for all competitions of age (U) categories:

Free program: max. 3:10 min

Shorter programs are not penalized.

Program content: Total amount of elements is nine (9)

a) Jumps

Max. of six (6) listed jump elements are allowed. In the categories of U 8, 9, and 10 one of the jump element has to be an Axel Paulsen type (A waltz jump meets this requirement but does not earn a value of points).

There are up to two (2) jump combinations or jump sequences allowed. The jump combination must to consist of max. two (2) jumps. The jump combination can consist of any number of jumps, but only the jumps with the highest listed value are included in the call.

Jump repetitions: Every jump can only be shown twice (2); exception in U 7, where every jump is allowed to be shown three times. Jumps with the same name but different number of revolutions are counted as different jumps.

A maximum of two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 ½) revolutions can be repeated when once shown in a jump combination or jump sequence (so max. two (2) times).

b) Spins

Max. two (2) different spins of different nature are permitted to be shown. One of this spins must to be a spin in only one basic position. (Different nature means, that the abbreviation is not matching to each other).

c) Step sequence

Max. of one (1) step sequence is allowed.

Program components:

The following 3 components will be judged:

- Skating Skills
- Composition
- Presentation

The factor of the Program Components is 1,73 (according to DKB [20220927_DFBest_DKB_EK.pdf \(eislauf-union.de\)](#))

Age classification:

a) Age category U 7 (younger)

Open for participants who have not reached the age of 7 until 30.06.2022

b) Age category U 8 (younger)

Open for participants who have not reached the age of 8 until 30.06.2022

c) Age category U 9 (younger)

Open for participants who have not reached the age of 9 until 30.06.2022

d) Age category U10 (younger)

Open for participants who have not reached the age of 10 until 30.06.2022

3.2. Age Category Synchronized Skating

Based on rules of Advanced Novice

Must at least be 10 by July 1st 2022, but not older than 15.

16 skaters with up to 4 alternates
