24rd Masters' International Speed Skating Master Cup 2026 Berlin-Lichtenberg/GERMANY February 28th – March 1th, 2026

The competition will be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest and the Regulations of the IMSSC and of the ISU at the covered 400m standard speed skating track in the Sportforum, Konrad-Wolf-Straße 39, Berlin-Lichtenberg, on artificial ice. This competition is a regular event on the International IMSSC and ISU Master's calendar.

1. Competitions

The competition will take place on Saturday 28th of February and Sunday 1 of March 2026.

Competition program

Ladies (age groups 20 and higher): 500 m, 1.500 m / 1.000 m, 3.000 m Men allround small (all age groups): 500 m, 3.000 m / 1.500 m, 5.000 m Men allround mini (all age groups): 500 m, 1.500 m / 1.000 m, 3.000 m

Quartet start is possible on all distances.

Every skater that has finalized three distances according IMSSC and ISU rules, is allowed to skate the fourth and longest distance.

3. Eligibility:

To be eligible the skater must be a member of a National Speed Skating Federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license of his/her federation.

4. Limitation of Participants

The competition is restricted to 100 skaters (respectively 120 entries; by experience about 15 % loss of entered competitors by illness, injuries, etc.).

If the number of entries exceeds the time frame for this competition, we may set a time limit for the long distance.

5. Drawing and Classification

On the first two distances of the Master Cup 2026 the skaters shall be seeded in groups before drawing, according to their best times of the season (if no time is available their best time of the season 2024/2025). Drawing will be done in accordance with Regulation 2.15 of the IMSSC Constitution and Regulation 2024-2025 v1 and later versions.

The classification will be done separately in five years age groups independent of the number of participants in an age group. The drawing and the results will be published www.eisschnelllauf.berlin

6. Prizes and results

The winner of the competition in his/her age group is the skater who has completed successfully all distances and has obtained the lowest total points in his/her five years age group.

The first three competitors in the overall ranking in each five years age group will be awarded a medal and a certificate.

7. Anti-Doping Conditions

Anti-doping tests will be carried out in accordance with ISU Rule 139 and the valid ISU Anti-Doping Rules (ISU Communication No. 2344) and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures (ISU Communication No. 2366) or any further update of these Communications. See also the Anti-doping guidelines of the IMSSC (https://imssc.org/mstr/anti-doping-guidelines/).
